The loss of sales tax revenue accompanying the closing of Shop 'N Save in Jerome will have a significant financial impact on the Village. The Board of Trustees has been working to address the gap in revenues by reducing expenses. To this end, the Board has voted to cancel the Annual Large Item Pickup normally held in August and September. Please see the related article in this bulletin for other options available to you. Additionally, at this point, only one branch pickup is scheduled, on April 1st.

I and the Board of Trustees are hopeful that when a new establishment goes into operation at the former Shop 'N Save location that sales taxes will again be generated. When this happens, we will reassess the Village's financial situation regarding these services.

At this time however, the priorities must be our roads, water system, community facilities, and police protection. We appreciate your cooperation as we all work to move forward during this time.

Monday, April 1st, 7:00am

There is one branch pickup scheduled for 2019. Branches <u>must</u> be out at the curb by 7:00 am on April 1st. **Any branches put out after that time will not be picked up**. This is the only way to assure that Public Works staff time is used efficiently. Branches put out any other time will result in a fine.

Branches will be picked up for free, up to piles 4' tall by 6' wide by 8' long, a standard truck bed size. Any pile bigger than that will not be picked up until a fee is paid. Fees start at \$75.

Branches should be under 8' long and no more than 6" around. Longer branches will need to be cut before being picked up and a fee of \$25 must be paid for this service prior to pick up.

Large Item Pickup Cancelled for 2019


Due to the need to concentrate Village Public Works staff time and resources on our roads, water system and community facilities, the large item pickup, normally held in August and September, is cancelled this year.

NO PARKING on West Side of Lincoln Avenue during Snow Emergency

The Village Board has designated several streets as snow emergency routes, meaning vehicles cannot be parked on the road when a snow emergency is declared. This allows snow plows to move through narrow streets unimpeded. Along with Homewood Court, Barbara Court, Reed Court, Scott Court and West Grand Court, the west side of Lincoln Avenue has recently been designated a snow emergency route. Please help out our Public Works staff by observing these designations. Vehicles left on these roads will be towed.



PLEASE REMEMBER:

- The Village Library is open year-round on Mondays from 10:00 a.m. to noon and from 6:00 - 8:00 p.m. If you are interested in volunteering to staff the library so we can expand hours call Trustee Kathy DeHart at 217-415-1132.
- If you hire a contractor to do work at your home, they must have a Contractor's Permit issued by the Village.
- Building permits are required for fences and other work done to the exterior of homes.
- The Village of Jerome does not pick up yard waste. Yard waste bags put out by the road must have a sticker on them purchased from your waste hauler.
- Our Village will look so much better if we all do our part by picking up trash that ends up in our yards and by bringing in garbage cans after pickup.
- Fire pit permit applications are available at the Village office. Outdoor fires are allowed between April 1 and November 30 with a proper permit.
- Parking is not allowed on yards.
